Hired 8 Paid High School Interns





We hired and trained 8 paid interns—a Phoenix record! Our shop interns learned the sales and service side of running a full-service bike shop, and our program interns learned how to teach hands-on bike mechanics to other youth as junior instructors.

Revamped our Bike Clubs



In addition to our year-round dropin Earn-a-Bike program, we ran bike clubs offsite (at local schools) in the spring and fall and onsite in the summer.
